Jan grew up in Minnesota and graduated from the University of Wisconsin – River Falls with a Bachelor's degree in Equine Science.

After graduation from college, Jan lived in Ferrara, Italy for over 20 years where she trained and showed reining and all-around horses. Her accomplishments include several Italian championships in Reining, finalist in the Italian Reining Derby & Futurity, finalist at Americana Open Reining, and she has taken many non-pros and youth to NRHA European championship titles and Italian championship titles. In 2007 she also won five silver medals at the APHA European Championships and high point awards in Trail and Halter for the Italian Paint Horse Association. She now shows cutting horses and in 2015 was NCHA Reserve World Champion in the \$35000 Non Pro Class and won various year end circuit championships in Texas, Arizona, and California.

She has judged many NRHA events including the Italian Derby, Maturity, & Futurity numerous times, Americana, NRHA European Futurity, the NRHA Derby in Oklahoma City, the German NRHA Derby, and numerous others. Among the many FEI events are included the very first CRIO in history held in Reggio Emilia, Italy in 2002, the World Reining Masters in Oklahoma City in 2009 and in Sweden in 2011, and the Young Riders Championship in Lexington, Kentucky in 2012 and the SWAG FEI European Championship at CS Ranch in 2017 among others. She has judged AQHA/APHA/ApHC/NSBA shows for over 15 years including Q8, Q12 and Q16, the ApHC European Championships & the AQHA European Championships, Appaloosa Nationals in Ft. Worth, TX, APHA World Show, SHTX World Show and numerous other breed shows in the US and Europe. She holds cards in NRHA/FEI, NRCHA, AQHA, APHA, ApHC, PtHA, ABRA, NSBA, SHTX, ASHA & NCHA (for Europe).

Jan now lives in San Angelo, Texas with her husband Chris where they ranch and raise a few cutting horses. She still travels to Europe often to judge horse shows.
